

ALBERTA JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS AGREEMENT

To all Parents/Legal Guardian of Juniors entering the Alberta Provincial Championship:

Please read the following information and sign at the bottom. By signing, you agree to the LBAA's policy regarding juniors attending the Canadian Junior Championship. If you have questions, please talk to the LBAA Executive Director.

The full policies are available on the LBAA website. The key points related to Alberta's junior champion's participation in the Canadian Junior Championship are:

For the winner of the applicable Provincial Junior Tournament, LBAA will,

- Provide coach support at the Canadian Junior Championship.
- Book and pay for accommodation for the player and chaperone if required.
- Book and pay for travel for a flight or arrange coverage of expenses if travel by car.
- Register the player with Bowls Canada Boulingrin.
- Provide the junior player with two provincial team shirts and a provincial jacket unless they already have one. Extra shirts can be bought from the LBAA office.
- Obtain Junior release form from parent/legal guardian (see copy attached)

Players entering the provincial tournaments must be aware of the dates of the Canadian Junior Championship and must be prepared to participate in such Championship should he/she win the right to represent Alberta.

If a parent desires to attend the Canadian Junior Championship with the player, he/she may share the athlete's hotel room at no cost. They are responsible for their own flight travel costs. Travel by vehicle means transporting the athlete and therefore gas costs by receipt are covered.
